Beginning Beading **BACK BY DEMAND**

Ages 16 and up

Instructor: Elaine Aquino

4 sessions: Wednesdays, July 6–27, 6:30–8:30 PM

Tuition: \$75

*Students will be introduced to various tools and techniques in this beginning beading class. Projects will include a lariat, an opera-length necklace, 3 strand and 6 strand bracelets. **Supplies needed for first class:** Chain-nose pliers, Diagonal wire cutters*

Botanical Art Workshop **NEW**

Tuition: \$125

*This one day intensive offers two unique opportunities: Instruction by Olivia Petrides, illustrator of two Peterson Field Guides to trees; And access to the Brincka Cross Gardens—home to hundreds of rare plant species. Appropriate for all levels, students will be instructed in how to capture the details and defining characteristics of plants in pencil and watercolor.
