Eligibility and Specifications:

PARTICIPANTS: The competition is open to woodturning artists 21 years of age or older.

ARTWORK: Woodturnings must be original art, conceived and executed solely by the turner in 2010, without instructional assistance. All work must be for sale, subject to a 35% commission which will benefit the Lubeznik Center for the Arts.

SPECIFICATIONS: Exhibiting turners will be showing artwork from non-endangered wood, indigenous to their region. Submissions must consist of two elements: The first will be a 6" x 6" x 3" block of wood that has been cut to size, but not worked in any other way. The second element will be a turning created from a similar 6" x 6" x 3" block of the same wood. This second element can be turned as is or disassembled, refashioned, and turned, just so long as the wood's features are not obscured by paint, bleach, etc. This turning can be from a burl or a root so long as the artwork fits within a volume 6" x 6" x 3". In the exhibit, the second element will be displayed on top of the first to illuminate the wood's character and to illustrate the before/after creative alteration.

Notification:

Entrants will be notified by mail of acceptance / rejection by November 12, 2010.

Sales and Reproduction:

Artwork must be for sale at 35% commission benefiting the Lubeznik Center. As a condition of entry, the artist grants the Lubeznik Center permission to reproduce entered images for publicity and education.

Entry Procedure:

ESTABLISH YOUR PIN#: This number will be associated with you and/or your entries throughout the duration of the show. The purpose is to maintain anonymity in the jury process. In the unlikely case there is a duplication, the Lubeznik Center will assign a new PIN# for you. We suggest using the last 4 digits of your phone number or driver's license number.

- Judging will be based on electronic files. No slides or photographs will be accepted.
- Each artist may submit up to 2 entries, with 1 image for each entry. Each image should show the turned work atop the base block.
- Images must be oriented with the top of the artwork appearing at the top of the screen.
- For jury reference, include the PIN# on the image (including the hyphenated number at the end of the specific entry). For example, assuming your PIN# is 1234, your 1st entry would be titled "1234-1."
- Images should be as JPEG, sized 1920 x 1920 pixels, at a minimum of 72 dpi, readable by both Mac and PC formats. No application file formats will be accepted.
- Files must be submitted on a CD. E-mailed files will not be accepted.
- Electronically title the image files with the PIN#, the title of the artwork and the wood type. Do not use your name in the filename.
- Label the outside top of the CD with artist's name.
- CD's will not be returned. Please keep a copy for your records.
- Delivered artwork not representative of accepted images will be disqualified.
- We will process payment for all submissions.

SEND THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

- Completed & signed entry form.
- Payment or credit card information – Entry fee is \$35 for the first entry and \$35 for a second entry, if desired (LCA members \$30 each). Fee is non-refundable.
- 1 CD, including labeled images for one or two entries.
- Self addressed and stamped #10 envelope, for notification, addressed to the Lubeznik Center for the Arts, 101 W. 2nd St., Michigan City, IN 46360. Entry must arrive by 5pm September 30, 2010.

Delivery of Accepted Artwork:

Work accepted into the exhibit may either be shipped or hand delivered to the Lubeznik Center for the Arts, 101 W. 2nd St., Michigan City, IN 46360 from February 7 – 11, 2011, during regular business hours. Shipped artwork must be in reusable containers, insured, with return shipping costs pre-paid – no exceptions. Make sure the container is sturdy and its contents are well packed. No styrofoam peanuts allowed. Shipped work arriving damaged will not be exhibited or repaired. Accepted works may not be withdrawn prior to the closing of the exhibit. All work must be ready for display.

Opening Reception:

All entering artists are invited to attend and bring guests to the opening reception on February 19, 2011, from 7 – 9 pm (Chicago time) at the Lubeznik Center for the Arts. Awards presentation begins at 8 pm.

Pick Up:

Hand-delivered artwork must be picked up from April 10, after 4 pm, through April 17 during regular hours. Shipped artwork will be repacked and mailed back by April 15, 2011. Works unclaimed by April 19, 2011 will be discarded.

Labeling of Accepted Artwork:

Labels (below) must be affixed to the bottom of each component. Labels may be duplicated. Since entries will consist of 2 pieces, the turned work should have the full label with title and price. The corresponding raw wood should have your name and PIN# affixed to its bottom.
