*En Plein Air is French for painting in the open air. Painting outdoors is about trying to capture the essence of a scene rather than a perfect reproduction, as the light is always changing. Students will learn what to bring and not to bring on a plein air trip. The instructor will bring several kinds of outdoor easels and wet painting holders. Holmaas will demonstrate her process, including the making of preliminary sketches to decide upon composition and values, and ways to capture light and shadows. Students will gather at the end of the day to share the experiences. Class will be held in Porter County's Brincka-Cross Gardens. All students will be able to participate in an exhibition at Brincka-Cross later in the year. Pack a bag lunch. **Supply list will be given upon registration.***

Wire Working *New!*

Tuition: \$75

Students will learn different techniques of wire working including: how to wire wrap cabochons and large beads, make links, pendants and coils. Each student will create a rosary chain—one long continuous chain with beads and wire. Instructor will demonstrate how to use a bench block and hammer to work harden dead soft wire. Tools needed are flush cutters, needle nose pliers, and bent nose or needle nose pliers

Young Artists' Studio
