

ARTS SCHOLARSHIPS FOR YOUNG ARTISTS AT LCA

The Dolly Fund is an endowed fund that provides scholarships for arts education at Lubeznik Center for the Arts (LCA). It was initiated by Paul Marshall in honor of his late wife and former LCA director, Dolly Marshall, to guarantee that arts education scholarships endure as part of LCA's mission to offer learning opportunities for students, age 7 to 18 – regardless of their ability to pay.

Requirements for Applicants:

- Applicant must be between 7 and 18 years of age at the time the instruction will take place.
- Applicant must show financial need by completing a simple form.
- The maximum grant request is \$200 per individual per year.
- · Applicant is expected to attend all classes and fill out a final report.

What We Fund:

- Classes at LCA that have an available opening and are scheduled to run.
- Priority will be given to those applicants who have not received prior scholarships from LCA.

Dispersement of Funds:

If application is approved, tuition payment is made directly to LCA, not the applicant.

Final Reports:

If approved, applicants will be expected to complete a final report and to attach a photograph of the artwork created in the class.

Deadlines:
